SUBJECT: Achievement Award - Chief's Commendation

On January 7, 2011, at or about 1906 hours, you were working third platoon in Manchester Township. While stationary at the intersection of North George Street and East 11th Avenue, you observed a blue Plymouth Neon make an illegal left-hand turn onto North George Street.

You initiated a traffic stop and found a 22-year old male from York as the driver. While obtaining his drivers license and registration card, you observed what you believed to be marijuana laying on the floor of the passenger side. You seized the marijuana and took the male into custody. You mirandized the male and began to interview him in regards to the possession of the drugs. This interview established probable cause that additional drugs would be located at the Super 8 Motel. You prepared a search warrant and later searched the motel room finding three and a half pounds of marijuana, six ounces of crack cocaine and over a thousand dollars in cash.

As a result of your alert observations at a traffic stop and your ability to conduct a thorough interview, a large amount of drugs were confiscated and the responsible party charged with the crime. We, as police officers are trained observers who rely on our instincts, in this case your experience served you well.
