Solicitor's Report - No report given.



Seven of the municipalities experienced a decrease in calls for police service in January 2021 compared to January 2020. Those municipalities are Dover, Manchester, Paradise, Jackson, North Codorus and Heidelberg Township as well as North York Borough. Four municipalities experienced an increase in calls for police service. Those municipalities are Conewago, Franklin and Manheim Township as well as Dover Borough.

In the area of traffic law enforcement, the following occurred during the month of January 2021 when compared to the month of January 2020:

Traffic citations were up from 1007 to 1356 Warning cards/faulty equipment cards were down from 497 to 433 Parking tickets remained unchanged at 3 Patrols conducted over 1,700 self-initiated traffic investigations during the month of January 2021. Not included in that figure are the 19 drivers arrested for Driving Under the Influence (DUI) of Drugs/Alcohol. The average BAC was .146 by volume, the lowest BAC being .104 and the highest BAC being .195 by volume.

The traffic accident summary reveals the following:

January 2020 there were 22 people injured January 2021 there were 21 people injured

January 2020 there were 18 injury accidents January 2021 there were 18 injury accidents

January 2020 there were a total of 166 accidents January 2021 there were a total of 148 accidents

During January 2021, Patrol and CID arrested 170 criminal defendants which is 32 less criminal arrests than January 2020. Of the 170 arrests, 32 were felonies, 81 were misdemeanors, and 57 were summary offenses.
