Ten of the municipalities experienced an increase in calls for police service in May 2021 compared to May 2020. Those municipalities are Dover, Manchester, Paradise, Conewago, Franklin, Jackson, North Codorus and Heidelberg Township as well as Dover and North York Borough. One municipality, Manheim Township experienced a decrease in calls for police service.

In the area of traffic law enforcement, the following occurred during the month of May 2021 when compared to the month of May 2020:

- Traffic citations were down from 1258 to 1139
- Warning cards/faulty equipment cards were down from 471 to 322
- Parking tickets were down from 73 to 67

Patrols conducted over 1,500 self-initiated traffic investigations during the month of May 2021. Not included in that figure are the 35 drivers arrested for Driving Under the Influence (DUI) of Drugs/Alcohol. The average BAC was .193 by volume, the lowest BAC being .06 and the highest BAC being .323 by volume.

The traffic accident summary reveals the following:

May 2020 there were 11 people injured  
May 2021 there were 30 people injured

May 2020 there were 11 injury accidents  
May 2021 there were 23 injury accidents

May 2020 there were a total of 105 accidents  
May 2021 there were a total of 163 accidents

During May 2021, Patrol and CID arrested 219 criminal defendants which is 13 less criminal arrests than May 2020. Of the 219 arrests, 40 were felonies, 109 were misdemeanors, and 97 were summary offenses.
