Six of the municipalities experienced an increase in calls for police service in April 2022 compared to April 2021. Those municipalities are Dover, Manheim, North Codorus and Paradise Township as well as Dover and North York Borough. Five of the municipalities experienced a decrease in calls for police service in April 2022 compared to April 2021. Those municipalities are Conewago, Franklin, Heidelberg, Jackson and Manchester Townships.

In the area of traffic law enforcement, the following occurred during the month of April 2022 when compared to the month of April 2021:

Traffic citations were down from 1310 to 968 -342
 Warning cards/faulty equipment cards were down from 301 to 287 -14
 Parking tickets were down from 23 to 20 -3

Patrols conducted over 1,200 self-initiated traffic investigations during the month of April 2022. Not included in that figure are the 14 drivers arrested for Driving Under the Influence (DUI) of Drugs/Alcohol. The average BAC was .182 by volume, the lowest BAC being .088 and the highest BAC being .264 by volume.

The traffic accident summary reveals the following:

April 2021 there were 18 people injured
April 2022 there were 23 people injured

April 2021 there were 15 injury accidents
April 2022 there were 18 injury accidents

April 2021 there were a total of 125 accidents
April 2022 there were a total of 144 accidents

During April 2022, Patrol and CID arrested 167 criminal defendants which is 79 less criminal arrests than April 2021. Of the 167 arrests, 15 were felonies, 79 were misdemeanors, and 73 were summary offenses.
