Chairperson Wilhide called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. In attendance were Commissioners Andrew Kroft, Michael Cashman, Mark Wenrich, Matthew Bollinger, Dave Brown, Rodney Brandstedter, Dennis Luckenbaugh, Nancy Brunk, Clark Craumer, Heather Billet and Chief Lash. Solicitor Rudolf was present.

After the Pledge of Allegiance, public comment was requested.

The minutes of the February 17, 2023, meeting were presented. A motion was made by Mark Wenrich, second by Michael Cashman, and carried 10-0 to accept the February minutes.

The Financial Report for February 2023, which includes earned interest, deposits, and withdrawals (checks written and EFT transactions), made to the Fulton Bank Checking Accounts, the Dorothy Kling Fund, and the Health Insurance Fund, was presented for approval. The Board accepted this report on a motion by Dennis Luckenbaugh, second by Nancy Brunk and unanimously carried.

Acceptance of Cpl Eligibility List: The list was presented with scores that will be effective for one year. Approval to Purchase Weapon Mounted Lights: The staff study prepared by Sgt. The recommendation was approved on a motion by Rodney Brandstedter, second by Dave Brown and unanimously carried.

Seven of the municipalities experienced a decrease in calls for police service in February 2023 compared to February 2022. Those municipalities are Conewago, Heidelberg, Jackson, Manheim, and North Codorus Township, as well as Dover and North York Borough. Four municipalities experienced an increase in calls for police service in February 2023 compared to February 2022. Those municipalities are Dover, Franklin, Manchester and Paradise Township.

In the area of traffic law enforcement, the following occurred during the month of February 2023 when compared to the month of February 2022:

Traffic citations were down from 1042 to 959 -83
Warning cards/faulty equipment cards were up from 308 to 386 +78
Parking tickets were up from 2 to 9 +7

Patrols conducted over 1,300 self-initiated traffic investigations during the month of February 2023. Not included in that figure are the 31 drivers arrested for Driving Under the Influence (DUI) of Drugs/Alcohol. The average BAC was .144 by volume, the lowest BAC being .089 and the highest BAC being .224 by volume.

The traffic accident summary reveals the following:

February 2022 there were 23 people injured
February 2023 there were 16 people injured

February 2022 there were 14 injury accidents
February 2023 there were 22 injury accidents

February 2022 there were a total of 142 accidents
February 2023 there were a total of 137 accidents

During February 2023, Patrol and CID arrested 185 criminal defendants which is 9 more criminal arrests than February 2022. Of the 185 arrests, 26 were felonies, 102 were misdemeanors, and 57 were summary offenses.
