Six of the municipalities experienced an increase in calls for police service in September 2023 compared to September 2022. Those municipalities are Conewago, Heidelberg, Manchester, Manheim and North Codorus Township as well as North York Borough. Five municipalities experienced a decrease in calls for service Dover, Franklin, Jackson and Paradise Township as well as Dover Borough.

In the area of traffic law enforcement, the following occurred during the month of September 2023 when compared to the month of September 2022:

Traffic citations were down from 1054 to 916 -138
Warning cards/faulty equipment cards were down from 331 to 304 -27
Parking tickets were down from 14 to 9 -5

Patrols conducted over 1,200 self-initiated traffic investigations during the month of September 2023. Not included in that figure are the 23 drivers arrested for Driving Under the Influence (DUI) of Drugs/Alcohol. The average BAC was .176 by volume, the lowest BAC being .100 and the highest BAC being .270 by volume.

The traffic accident summary reveals the following:

September 2022 there were 19 people injured
September 2023 there were 33 people injured

September 2022 there were 17 injury accidents
September 2023 there were 26 injury accidents

September 2022 there were a total of 166 accidents
September 2023 there were a total of 168 accidents

During September 2023, Patrol and CID arrested 202 criminal defendants which is 10 less criminal arrests than September 2022. Of the 202 arrests, 35 were felonies, 90 were misdemeanors, and 77 were summary offenses.
